Applications

Universities should submit nominations to us by:

1st May 2018 for September start

5th October 2018 for January start

We will accept nominations by email and they should include the students' name, email address, intended length of study, and subject area.

Once we have received your nomination, we will contact the student directly with details on how to apply. Applicants must also submit **copies** of their

- Transcript
- Passport details
- English language qualification if not a native speaker (Please note that we will accept a letter of support from your university if you do not hold a qualification). Please check our <u>website</u> for language requirements.

Incomplete applications will not be processed.

Application Deadlines

Trimester 1/Full year: 1st June 2018 Trimester 2: 2nd November 2018

Modules

Exchange students may select modules from a list which will be sent to their universities' Exchange Office. Module descriptors can be found here.

All GCU modules are 20 SCOTCAT credits = 10 ECTS credits

- 1 trimester: 3 modules = 60 SCOTCAT credits/30 ECTS credits
- 1 year: 6 modules = 120 SCOTCAT credits/60 ECTS credits
